



**SECURITY PLAN HM-232
NOTICE OF COMPLIANCE**

49 CFR 172.800-804 requires shippers and transporters of hazardous materials to create a written security plan aimed at preventing equipment and hazardous cargo from being used as a weapon in a terrorist act. The plan must outline, in detail, measures put in place and designed to make every reasonable effort to secure the shipments, facilities, and people involved. We recognize the need for assurance that Averitt Express has a plan in place and is in compliance with the training required by this regulation.

Excerpt from HM-232 final rule:


...a shipper should satisfy itself that the carrier that will be transporting it's material has a security plan in place that adequately addressed the assessed security risks of the material to be transported...
